

NEW DEVELOPMENTS

A 15 seater Toyota Hiace Bus was donated for the PSRD school children by World Rehabilitation Fund (WRF) and The PSRD Foundation (TPF). PSRD is very grateful to them and to the donors in United States whose generosity made this possible. It will be of great help in providing free pick and drop facilities to the children with disabilities who attend PSRD High School.



Renovation work has begun in PSRD Orthopaedic Hospital. The work will be done in phases. In the first phase, Male D ward will be renovated, along with bathrooms, Central Kitchen and Matrons Room. When refurbished, bed space will increase by almost 50%. A new much needed post op ward is also being made which will be used for patients recovering from surgery.

|BURKI PROJECT UPDATE |

Burki Project 2014 is going well. Under Child Health Component 70 children have been treated free of charge up to June 2014. CBR team along with lady doctor, physiotherapist and community worker have been visiting Burki regularly, holding clinics at Kim Gul Center and City Foundation School. Once again majority of cases (23) were children with Cerebral Palsy. Children who needed specialized treatment were brought to PSRD. Under Maternal Health 46 women have benefitted from free medical treatment, consultation and medicines up to June 2014.

Majority of the women (22) were antenatal cases who were given checkup, guidance on the importance of good diet, regular ultrasound, blood tests and regular checkup. They were provided with free supplements. Workshop was held on Maternal Health and Child Care on Saturday 14th June at the Kim Gul Center. It was attended by 70 women from the locality. Topics discussed included problems of early marriages, marriages with close relatives, forcible marriages, marked disparity in age etc. A local NGO also gave a presentation. The workshop was very much appreciated by all the ladies present.



| Success Story |

Hamid Ghulam Rasul, 13 yrs of age is a student of Class 6 in The Citizen Foundation school. He is the oldest of five children. His father works as a labourer in a metal shop and finds it hard to make ends meet and support the family. Hamid was born with his right leg substantially shorter than his left leg because of which he could only walk with great difficulty. Hamid was brought to the PSRD for his first check up on 29th April, 2013 and was advised by Dr. Javed Iqbal that he would need a series of operations. However, due to his physical weakness, he had to be first given supplements to help him get fit for the surgery. Following X-ray and blood tests, he was operated on 5th July, 2013.

His second operation took place on 6th January, 2014, third operation on 20th March, 2014 when he was measured and fitted with AFO and appropriate shoe. Fourth operation took place on 8th April, 2014 in which contracture of his knee was straightened. All these interventions were carried out by PSRD under the Burki Project, absolutely free of charge. Subsequent to the surgeries he has been checked by the medical staff at regular intervals. He now walks easily with the AFO. He and his family are very grateful to the CBR dept., PSRD medical staff and the project donor for this help.


